Determine the financial and logistical support your committee can provide to attract the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tour.

Step Three

Apply to the RFP by downloading the form below and submitting an application at least 3 months prior to anticipated tour dates.

OVERVIEW

Great Awakening seeks **8 host cities** for its Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tours to take place throughout the year. The World Tour is a gathering of awakened people in your area or persons curious about their Hebrew Identity with the objective of building unity and strengthening relationships between the Hebrew community. This is an unique opportunity for a city to host the largest Hebrew Gathering in the Country to the audience of hundreds of the dispersed of Israel, network with the country's leading and emerging Hebrew voices, and to awaken people in your area to their biblical heritage. With the 2020 World Tour, Great Awakening looks for partners who can help awaken Black America in their area. We are actively taking proposals and looking for partnerships and sponsorships that can expand the impact of the awakening movement.

GREAT AWAKENING

Great Awakening is a not-for-profit ministry, founded in 2019, whose purpose is to bring together people from all settings who are awakened to or curious about their Hebrew Identity with the objective of building unity and strengthening relationships between the Hebrew community and the business, academic, social, political and faith sectors to enhance their roles in the awakening movement. More than 100 thousand people visited Great Awakening 's website in 2019, another 150,000 follow its coverage on social media, and 40,000 subscribe to YouTube coverage. All are in search of their true identity.

ABOUT THE WORLD TOURS

Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tours is an 8 city tour gathering of the leading and rising Hebrew voices in the world, who through their groundbreaking work and ministries are uniquely designed to awaken, teach, and train the masses on the original history, people, and doctrine of the Scriptures.

World Tour Objectives:

- To support the World Tours focus, "The Great Awakening", by providing attendees with practical knowledge and tools that they can use to continue to awaken the dispersed of Israel.
- To raise awareness about how African Americans and other Bantus Negroes around the world are fulfilling biblical prophecy by rediscovering their ancient identity
- To showcase diversity in the Hebrew culture across diverse factions and settings
- To support networking and sharing among Hebrews (African Americans) from all settings within the business, entertainment, academic, political and faith continuum.
- To continue to build the momentum and celebrate the culture of the Hebrew community in the US and beyond.
- To highlight the people, assemblies, organizations, and education in advancing the Hebrew movement.
- Increases awareness of, knowledge about, and appreciation for issues unique to African American who have discovered their Hebraic roots.
- Seeks to educate and update African Americans on trends and issues related to the rapidly growing Hebrew community through sharing information on research, educational opportunities, regional resources, new communities, prophetic events, community issues, and trends.

Starting in 2019 and each year afterwards, Great Awakening will announce an open call for World Tour participants. Great Awakening is expected to receive more than 50 applications but can only select 8 applications annually. These 8 Tours to Cities, joined by leading voices in the Hebrew Community, host city committee members, and Great Awakening staff, gather for three days of presentations, workshops, movie, concert, shabbat service and more to collectively increase the awareness of the awakening in cities where the dispersed of Israel are located. This immersive conference includes

- Up to 20 workshops
- Up to 16 speakers (leading Hebrew voices)

- Hebrew Forum and Panel Discussion
- Hebrew AfterGlow Meet and Greet
- Registration Bag and All Conference Materials

It is an opportunity for The Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tours to leave a meaningful mark in the host city. We work with each host committee to set a theme that resonates in the communities we visit. On such a compressed conference timeline, we don't presume (nor do we attempt) to swoop in and "solve" for spiritual challenges of people of color that cities may have struggled with for decades. Instead, each workshop and speaker bring expertise to and turns a fresh lens on such pressing issues, hoping that by the Ruach their presentations will lead to incremental and extendable progress to waking more people of color up in your community.

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

The Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes TOURS have gathered some the most prestigious national and global leaders in Hebrew movement that will share in symposium and workshop formats. There's a broad range of faith and academic leaders, speakers, pastors, morehs, children & youth leaders, and training instructors you will encounter at the Conference. Workshops for all ages will be interactive and experiential, providing an engaging space where participants actively engage with ideas and have opportunities for critical reflection and dialogue with the speaker and each other.

Workshop 101: Sister Circle (Women Only) This all women workshop is provide a time for sisters to fellowship, pray and learn as Hebrew women in a safe space so we can meet Yahshua the redeemer, be filled with the Ruach Ha'Kodesh and/or discover our callings.

Workshop 102: Making of A Hebrew Man (Men Only) This all men workshop is provide a time for brothers to fellowship, pray, discuss concerns and pray together as Hebrew men.

Workshop 201: Homestead Living This class teaches practical living skills and the desire to make learning these skills accessible in a culture that has virtually abandoned them. Learn to develop community as demonstrated in the Book of Acts, live off the grid, sustainable living, and grow nutritious foods for you and your family. Through this featured workshop, you will quickly gain the knowledge and skills to plan your family homestead

Workshop 202: Hebrew Coop/Financial Stewardship As Hebrews we take full responsibility for the economic destiny of our communities and nations. This workshop will help the Hebrew Community put in place successful business models that give us the capacity to gain significant control of the economics of our community, and to help free us from the current state of economic domination and exploitation by multiple forces in the world.

Workshop 203: Hebrew Marriages This workshop designed for Married Couples will help them to invest in their marriages and intentionally move towards oneness. The Laws help Hebrew marriages to understand Yah's blueprint for marriage so you can create a legacy of greatness.

Workshop 204: Awakened Now What? This spiritual awakening is a tremendous gift from Yah that leaves us exhilarated, inspired, and full of new awareness and perspective. WE have undergone a profound shift and are forever transformed. So now what? Where do we go from here?

Workshop 206: Hebrews to Negroes 1 This first of three workshops taught by the Author of Hebrews to Negroes, Ronald Dalton Jr., will continue explore the original Hebrews of the Bible. Attendees will look at how the Transatlantic Slave Trade was foretold in Scriptures and they understand those Africans who were enslaved in the Americas as Israelites, severed from their heritage.

Workshop 301: Healthy Hebrews: Diet and Nutrition This specifically added to the Conference to provide information to Hebrews about the Biblical Diet and how it promotes optimum health results. This workshop will assist all attendees of varying literacy levels make appropriate health and food selection decisions.

Workshop 302: Secular Legal Rights for Hebrew will discuss some of the secular protections affecting the Hebraic community under the First Amendment Freedom of Speech and Religion Establishment Clause, as well as other laws pertaining to religious liberty and freedom. What rights do I have if my employer wants me to work on the Sabbath? What do I need to know if I want to home school my children? What rights do I have to decline vaccination or medical treatment for myself or my children? What is a legal marriage in the United States?

Workshop 304: The Return of The Ezer Kenegdo: Yah's Call to Women In this workshop you will examine ancient Hebraic culture and customs separated from Greco-Roman influence and we will uncover Hebraic womanhood through the Matriarchs of our faith and the archetypes of Hebraic womanhood such as the Ezer Kenegdo (Helpmate), Eschet Chayil (Virtuous Woman) and the Queen Mother. Through readings, video clips and writing we will examine the special role Yah has for the Hebrew woman and how Greco-Roman influence has suppressed this role.

Workshop 303: Decoding the Medu Neter: Learn from the most sought after scholar on the Medu Neter language how Ancient Egyptian language reveals the presence of Hebrews in ANC Kemet.

Workshop 305: Defending the Biblical Law Almost all of the Christian world regards Paul's letters as "proof" that we need not concern ourselves with keeping Yah's Torah/law. This is a major mistake that must be addressed thoroughly. It is often more difficult for a person to 'unlearn error' than to 'learn truth.' This class will teach you how to defend the Laws of Yah and accurately share the it with others.

Workshop 306: Hebrews to Negroes 2 This 2nd workshop taught by the Author of Hebrews to Negroes, Ronald Dalton Jr., will continue explore the original Hebrews of the Bible. Attendees will look at how the Transatlantic Slave Trade was foretold in Scriptures and they understand those Africans who were enslaved in the Americas as Israelites,

severed from their heritage. Israelites of all stripes today point to specific scriptures as prophetic proof of their ancestry, particularly Deuteronomy 28.

Workshop 401: Hebrew Migration into Africa Learn how many of Israel and Judah denizens escaped the wrath of invading armies, and migrated to the nearest borderline of Africa. Learn how some of the tribes' descendants intermarried and adopted their African native host's culture and religions (Christianity conversion as well) and throughout the centuries, lost their ethnic identity and forsook YAH.

Workshop 402: Sharing the Hebrew Faith with your Family This workshop will equip you with the tools and techniques to share the awakening message with your family and friends in a non-hostile manner.

Workshop 403: 1619—The Children of Judah If you want to learn more about the true Hebrew Israelites, then this workshop is for you. In recent years, more and more Hebrew Israelites are waking up to their true identity according to the bible, books of antiquity, DNA research, archaeological research, and more. In this workshop, we will discuss events in the Iberian peninsula which led to the Transatlantic Slave trade. We'll see how the Spanish Inquisition, expulsion edicts, and Papal Bulls all played critical parts in the scattering of the true Children of Israel to the four corners of the earth. We will also discuss some little known truths of 1619 and the first slaves who settled in the English colonies. You will not want to miss this shocking revelation. Come and rediscover your true history.

Workshop 405: Understand Biblical Feasts This workshop will explore the Feasts of the Bible and help students see and understand how Yah had a redemptive plan for mankind in mind from the beginning. The feasts of Israel in the Old Testament point the way to Yah's appointed schedule with His people—reminding us of his provision and care in our lives. This Feasts of the Bible course identifies each key feast in the Bible, explains its significance, symbolism, timelessness, and purpose—all pointing to the Messiah.

Workshop 406: Hebrews to Negroes 3 This 3rd workshop taught by the Author of Hebrews to Negroes, Ronald Dalton Jr., will continue explore the original Hebrews of the Bible. Attendees will look at how the Transatlantic Slave Trade was foretold in Scriptures and they understand those Africans who were enslaved in the Americas as Israelites, severed from their heritage. Israelites of all stripes today point to specific scriptures as prophetic proof of their ancestry, particularly Deuteronomy 28. This signature workshop will look through a prophetic lens foretelling of slavery and servitude in the Americas.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

In selecting a city to host The World Tour, Great Awakening seeks one or more Lead Sponsors who can provide financial support and collaborate with Great Awakening to shape the conference. The Lead Sponsor will provide a direct contact for Great Awakening to speak with on a bi-monthly basis throughout the planning of the conference. Lead sponsors will work with Great Awakening to develop shared goals and issue areas/themes for the conference. Great Awakening is also open to and interested in working with corporations and universities. Lead sponsors collaborate with Great Awakening to select and invite local awakened believers representing diverse sectors and interests to serve on a conference Host Committee.

Host Committee: Members of the Host Committee, including representatives of sponsoring organizations, representatives of local Hebraic groups, and other stakeholders will work with Great Awakening staff to chart the conference's programming, logistics, and theme. Critically, the committee curates local attractions that showcase exciting initiatives and innovative projects, as well as areas of the city that demonstrate its challenges. The Host Committee will participate in the conference, engage and network with Great Awakening H2N World Tours at various receptions, and play a strategic role in executing. Activities may include:

- Participate in regular conference calls;
- Connect Great Awakening with local vendors and locations;
- Provide on-site support for events, where necessary;
- Promote attendance at any Great Awakening events open and coordinate local PR efforts;
- Promote conference to local awakened communities, assemblies, camps, and churches

BUDGET

The cost of organizing and holding the conference depends on the location, lodging options and finalized agenda and activities. Great Awakening and the Lead Sponsor(s) will work together to raise additional grants and corporate sponsorships that enhance the overall content. Some in-kind contributions, such as free event space, can offset hard costs. A key aspect of the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tour is that attendee's costs are kept to a minimum. To ensure the sustainability of this tour, and to grow it in future years, Great Awakening works with partners to develop a budget that enables the conference to channeled money back into the Lead Sponsors/Host Committee to further the work of the Awakening in that City and builds capacity for future Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tours and other important programs. **Great Awakening is a not-for-profit ministry and does not seek to gain profit from tours. The figures present below are the exact dollars necessary to cover the expenses of the Tour ONLY!**

Option 1: Lead Sponsors and/or Host Committee gives a **\$5,000** non-refundable fee to the Great Awakening and Great Awakening will lead all activities and collect all monies. A minimum of 250 people must register for the event. The Host City will receive the following:

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Proposal Requirements To apply to become a host city, please submit a comprehensive proposal that includes the following information 3 months prior to tour date to greatawakening400@gmail.com.

Letter of Interest (3-page max) The letter should include the following information:

- Brief description of the Lead Sponsor(s) and your vision for the Great Awakening Hebrews to Negroes World Tour in your city;
- How your organization's, assembly's, activities align with the conference, and your anticipated outcomes;
- Proposed dates of the tour (must be 3 months before anticipated tour dates)
- Suggested opportunities and challenges that would serve as the basis for the content development of the conference;
- One or more ideas for how to make the tour to your city unique, bigger, better or more impactful;
- Your funding commitment and strategy, including detail on secured and/or pledged funds, in addition to any other ideas for support;
- An overview of the strengths and resources of your organization(s) and Host Committee, specifically your experience with tours, event planning, hosting conferences, or other relevant activities.

Proposed Host Committee (1-page max) Please include the organization name and a brief description of each organization. Please include proposed host member names and titles, if possible. Host committees should be representative of the awakened Israelites in your city.

Supporting Material Please send material on your city, including basic information and demographics on estimated awakened people and those who are interested in the awakening, recent innovations, case studies, challenges. These can be in any format, including written information, videos, or links.

Evaluation Criteria Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria.

- Financial Feasibility:** The applicant has demonstrated a financial commitment and proposed fundraising strategy;
- Innovation and Synergy:** The host city has a group of awakened leaders who are enthusiastic and committed to the awakening of the dispersed of Israel. There are clear, shared goals and interests and innovative ideas that will enhance the existing platform and expand the awakening in that city;

- C. **Experience Lead sponsors and Host Committee:** are committed to improving their city and have experience with the content areas, multi-faceted partnerships, developing conferences and/or similar eve
- D. **Prayer:** Great Awakening will spend some time in prayer before Yah and pray about whether it is the right opportunity to come to your city
