



GREAT AWAKENING ASSEMBLIES LEAD MOREH COVENANT AGREEMENT

As a Great Awakening Assembly, we covenant together according to the following:

1. We agree to hold firmly to sound doctrinal position and to the Great Awakening Doctrinal Statement
2. We agree to be an assembly governed by biblically qualified leaders.
3. We agree to teach a clear presentation of the Torah & Besorah (Gospel) in every Teaching and to make personal spreading the awakening message (evangelism) a top priority in our lives.
4. We will diligently strive to place our marriages and families as our top priority.
5. We agree to strive to become financially self-supporting according to the timeline presented during the Intensive Training to and approved the Zaqen Council of the Great Awakening.
 - a. Once we are self-supporting, we will work with the Great Awakening to strategically give to the general monthly offerings to planting other Assemblies, support World Missions and give benevolences to fellow assemblies.
6. We agree to lead or support our local assembly of humbleness and unity. Should we ever feel that we have been wronged, we will make the offense known in love. We will walk closely with others in the Great Awakening Mish'pacha and in our own relational circles to be an assembly that is above reproach. We will strive to foster a healthy, dynamic, and collaborative relationship between our Assembly and the Great Awakening Mish'pacha.
7. We agree that the Great Awakening Moreh/Morah Council and Zaqens Council will arbitrate over any dispute that arises between the Moreh and the Assembly's leaders or congregation and that all parties involved will adhere to the decision made by the Great Awakening Moreh Council and/or Zaqens Council.
8. Participate in the Great Awakening training before starting the assembly.
9. Send reports (when applicable) to the Great Awakening for our records

- 10.** Commit to the fulfillment of the Biblical functions of an assembly (Worship, Evangelism, Discipleship, Fellowship, Missions, and Ministry)
- 11.** Commit to the doctrinal statement of the Great Awakening
- 12.** Submit to an evaluation of spiritual health and development each Spring and Fall.

The undersigned partners enter a covenant to plant a new assembly in the City of _____ in State/Province of _____ in the Country of _____ under the direction of Yahuah through the commission of the Great Awakening Mish'pacha. The common goal is to reach the lost sheep of Israel and the spiritual lost through the planting of an Awakened Messianic Ruach-Filled Assembly, which will soon become self-sustaining and self-reproducing.

This covenant agreement is to be evaluated on a yearly basis. This partnership can be dissolved by the failure of any party to fulfill the covenant agreement or by simply mutual agreement of all parties.
